- 4. What was the *motive* for the Incarnation?
- 5. The *kenosis* theory suggests that Jesus had to give up some divinity to become man, do you agree with this? Why will this theory not stand?
- 6. What, in your own words, is "the Christmas spirit"? How is the church today failing to exhibit it? What are some specific actions you could perform to manifest the Christmas spirit?
- 7. Why is the Incarnation the supreme mystery of the gospel? What effects should being aware of the Incarnation have on each of us?
