Week 2: Read Nehemiah Chapter 5:14-19

- 1. When has someone been generous to you?
- 2. What is the significance of Nehemiah not taking the governor's allowance?
- 3. What was Nehemiah's motivation for his attitude? (v15)
- 4. Nehemiah (v16) was also heavily involved in building the wall, not just supervising. What can this show us about generosity?
- 5. Generosity is not just giving money to people/charities. How does v16 help us think about what we can do to be more generous?
- 6. Again, Nehemiah talks about not taking the allowance (v18) in what circumstances do we feel entitlement? Is it ever justified?
- 7. In what ways is God generous to us?
- 8. Spend some time looking at these verses about financial generosity:

Rom 12:13, II Cor 8:14, Eph 4:28, Phil. 4:16, I Tim 5:3, 16, James 1:27, I Jn 3:17

Discuss in your group the different ways we can be generous as a community. Chat about which ones you find easier to live out, and which ones you find difficult.
