- 5. Why would Nehemiah's position of authority be an asset in improving the situation?
- 6. How good are we at recognising need in others?
- 7. If God knows all our fears, desires, and needs, why does he want us to pray about them?
- 8. Based on this passage, what are some of the ingredients of effective prayer?
- 9. In what ways can prayer change a person's attitude towards life's difficulties?
- 10. In what ways does God bless those who continually turn to him in prayer?
